

Dr. Jemal H. Abawajy is a full professor at Deakin University, Australia, where he serves as the Director of the Distributed System and Security Research, a research strength within the University, leading a group of academics, research staff, and postgraduate students (30+ members). In 2016, he was awarded Doctorate of Science (DSc.) by Deakin University for his outstanding research achievements. He authored/co-authored seven books and more than 300 papers in premier venues such as IEEE Transactions on Computers, IEEE Transaction on Cloud Computing, IEEE Communications Surveys and Tutorials, IEEE Transactions on Fuzzy Systems, IEEE Transactions on Emerging Topics in Computing, IEEE Transactions on Information Technology in Biomedicine, IEEE Transactions on Evolutionary Computation, and IEEE Transactions on Services Computing. He has been actively involved in the organisation of more than 300 national and international conferences in various capacity including chair, general co-chair, vice-chair, best paper award chair, publication chair, session chair and program committee. He has served on the editorial-board of numerous international journals including the IEEE Transaction on Cloud Computing.
